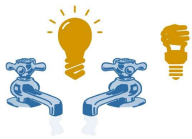
Annual Report for 2021 Calendar Year

Feeding the Hungry

Thanks to our partnerships with Clark County Food Bank, Bi-Zi Farms, and other local businesses, we are able to provide fresh produce, bread, and a variety of other foods along with a generous box of staples. Last year, over 1,100 families received over 51,000 pounds of food from our pantry.



Gas, Electricity and Water

In 2021, we helped 20 families keep their heat and lights on and their water running.



Rent assistance

Staying in their homes keeps families safe and strong. In 2021, we helped 139 families stay in their homes. Requests for assistance have been very high this past year due to COVID-19.



Thanksgiving and Christmas

During the Holidays, we provided almost 100 families with deluxe Thanksgiving boxes and 36 families with Christmas presents and stockings for 121 children, plus a food box and a turkey. Thank You to the many who helped with these projects!!

- \$70,800 parishioners and other donors

- \$2,200 Grants / Other

What do our Funds Support?

- 79% Rental Assistance and Emergency Shelter
- 5% Utility Assistance/Propane
- 6% Other Assistance (transportation, school, etc)
- 4% Food Assistance (Most food is donated)
- 6% Administrative expenses
